
Christmas Lapbook





Print the envelope on card paper. Fold the back part up and the sides in and glue closed. Glue the back of your envelope to your file folder and place the present missing number cards inside.






Cut the number strips out. Cut the presents out and use to complete the missing numbers in the correct order.


Beginning Letters
