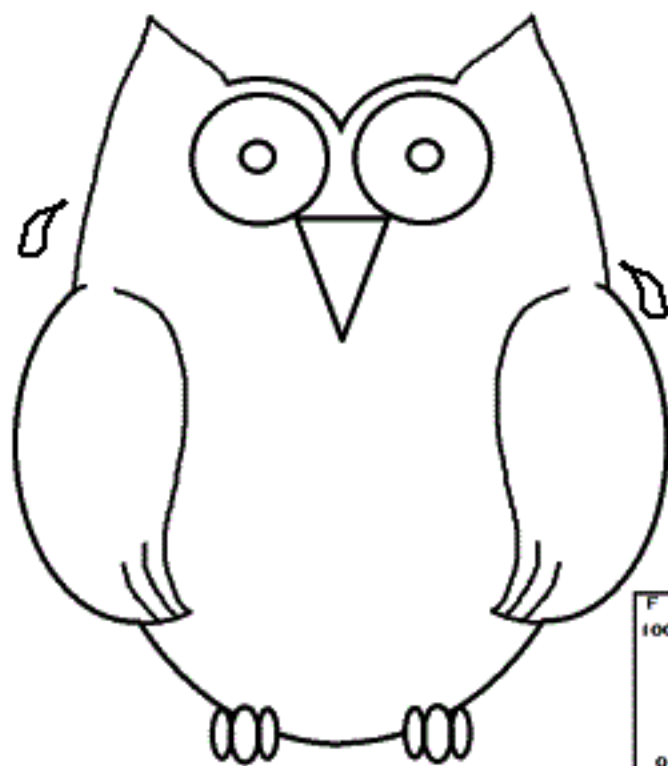

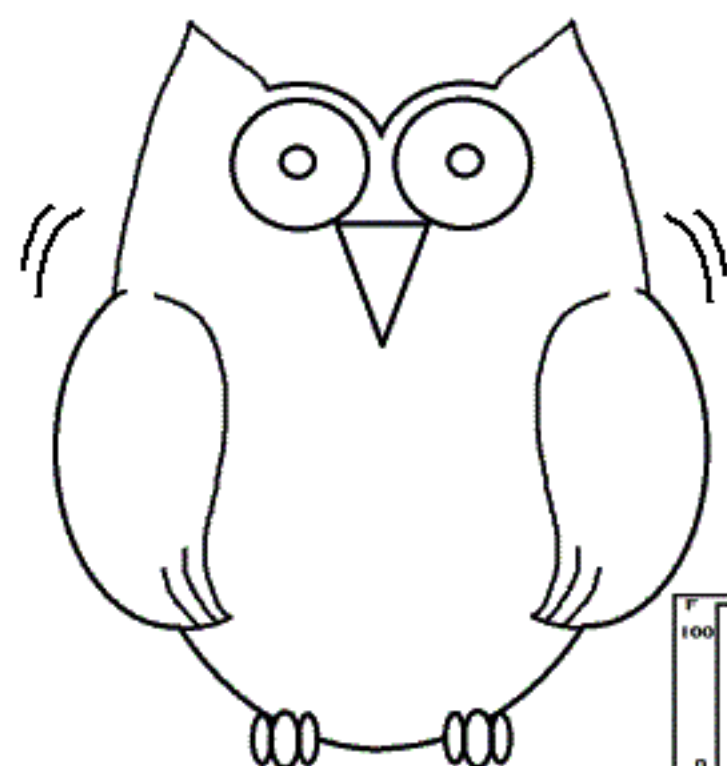

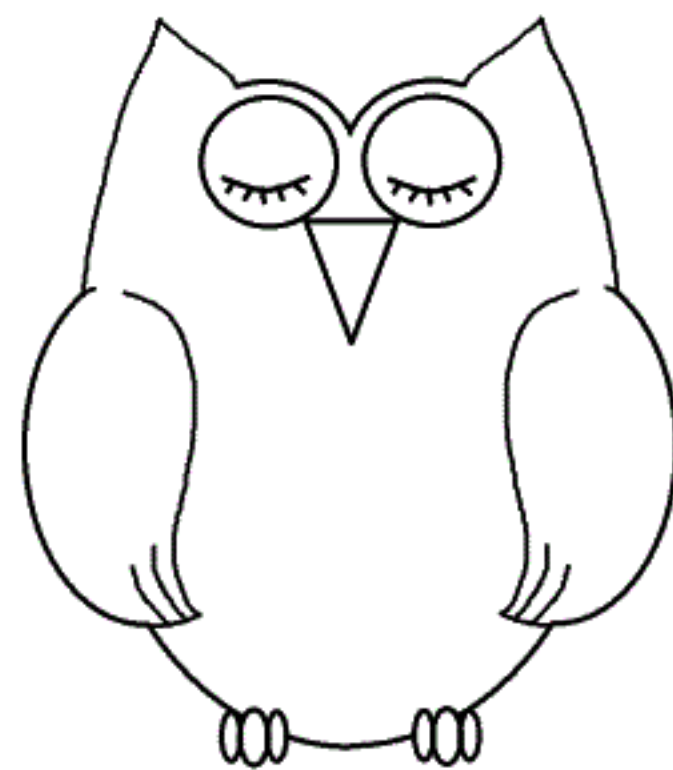
The cup is empty.
